Crochet Pattern

Material:

- crochet hook size 2,5
- Catania wool from Schachenmayr in gray, white and green or any wool you wish
- sewing needle
- 2 eyes made out of glass or plastic (safety eyes) 9 mm
- fiberfill

Size: Elephant Jojo has a height of about 12 cm (4,72 inches)

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

R - round or row

sc – single crochet

Number x sc – the number tells you how many times you make a single crochet
(or a dc, hdc ...) in each stitch

inc - make two single crochet in one stitch

dec - two stitches crochet together with a sc

sl st - slip stitch

sc with color change: change the color on this sc (when you make this single crochet stitch, grab the new color of your wool and pull it through the two loops on your hook).

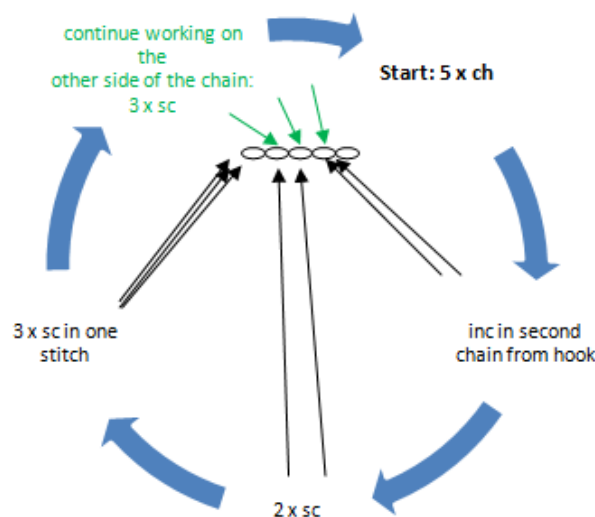
Note:

Unless indicated otherwise, the parts for Jojo are worked in rounds. You can start with 2 ch or make a magic ring. Make the arms, legs and the trunk before you start with the body, because they are crocheted to the body. The rows should be marked with a thread. Don't remove the thread marks on the legs, you need them for orientation when you crochet the legs to the body.

Legs (2 x)

5 ch in color green

R 01 inc in second ch from hook, 2 x sc, 3sc in one stitch,
 continue working on the other side of the chain: 3 x sc, see drawing **10**



R 02	2 x inc, 2 x sc, 3 x inc, 2 x sc, inc	16
R 03	sc in each stitch	16
R 04	5 x sc, 5 x dec, sc	11
R 05	4 x sc, 3 x dec, sc	8
R 06	sc with color change to gray, 4 x sc, dec, sc, stuff the foot	7
R 07 – R 11	sc in each stitch	7
	sl st, cut the thread. Don't stuff the legs. Leave the thread marks inside the legs, you need them later for orientation, when you crochet the legs to the body.	

Arms (2 x)

2 ch in color gray

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	(2 x sc, inc) x 2	8
R 03	sc in each stitch	8
R 04	(2 x sc, dec) x 2	6
R 05	sc in each stitch, stuff the hand only	6
R 06 – 09	sc in each stitch	6
R 10	5 x sc, sc with color change to white	6
R 11	sc in each stitch	6
R 12	sc in each stitch	6
	sl st, cut the thread. Don't stuff the arm.	

Trunk

2 ch in color gray

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02 – R 05	sc in each stitch	6
R 06	inc, 5 x sc	7
R 07	6 x sc, inc	8
R 08	4 x sc, inc, 3 x sc	9
R 09	inc, 8 x sc	10
R 10	9 x sc, inc	11
R 11	5 x sc, inc, 5 x sc	12
R 12	(sc, inc) x 6	18
	sl st, cut the thread. <u>Do not stuff the trunk</u>	

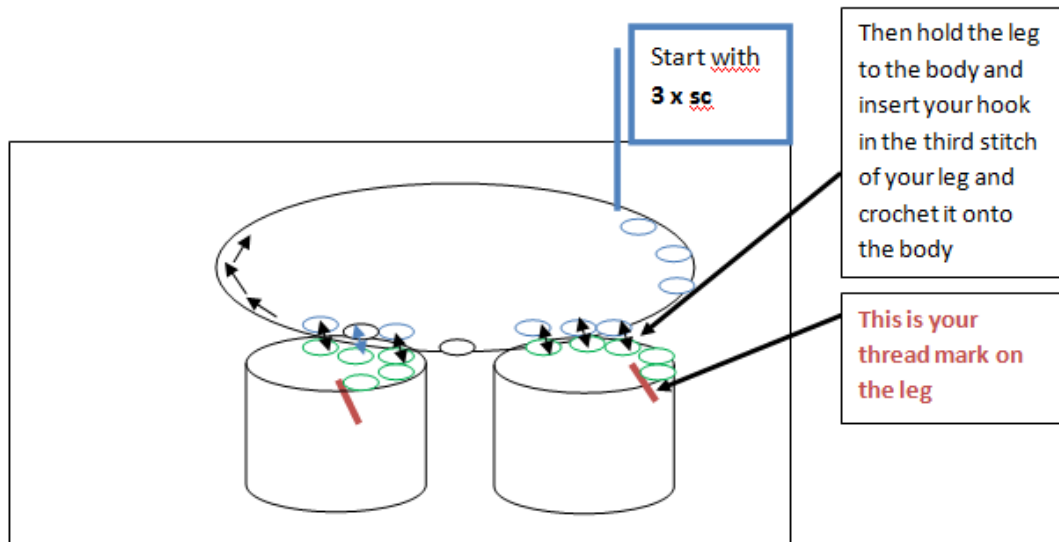
Body and head

2 ch in color gray

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	inc in each stitch	12
R 03	(sc, inc) x 6	18

R 04 **3 x sc**, then start to crochet the leg to the body.

Where to start on the leg: count back three stitches from your thread mark (see picture), hold the leg to the body and crochet the stitches of the leg and the body together. See the picture underneath and the drawing.



crochet the stitches of the leg and the body together with **3 x sc**
now only over the body: sc,
 crochet the stitches of the second leg and the body together with **3 x sc**
and then only over the body: 8 x sc

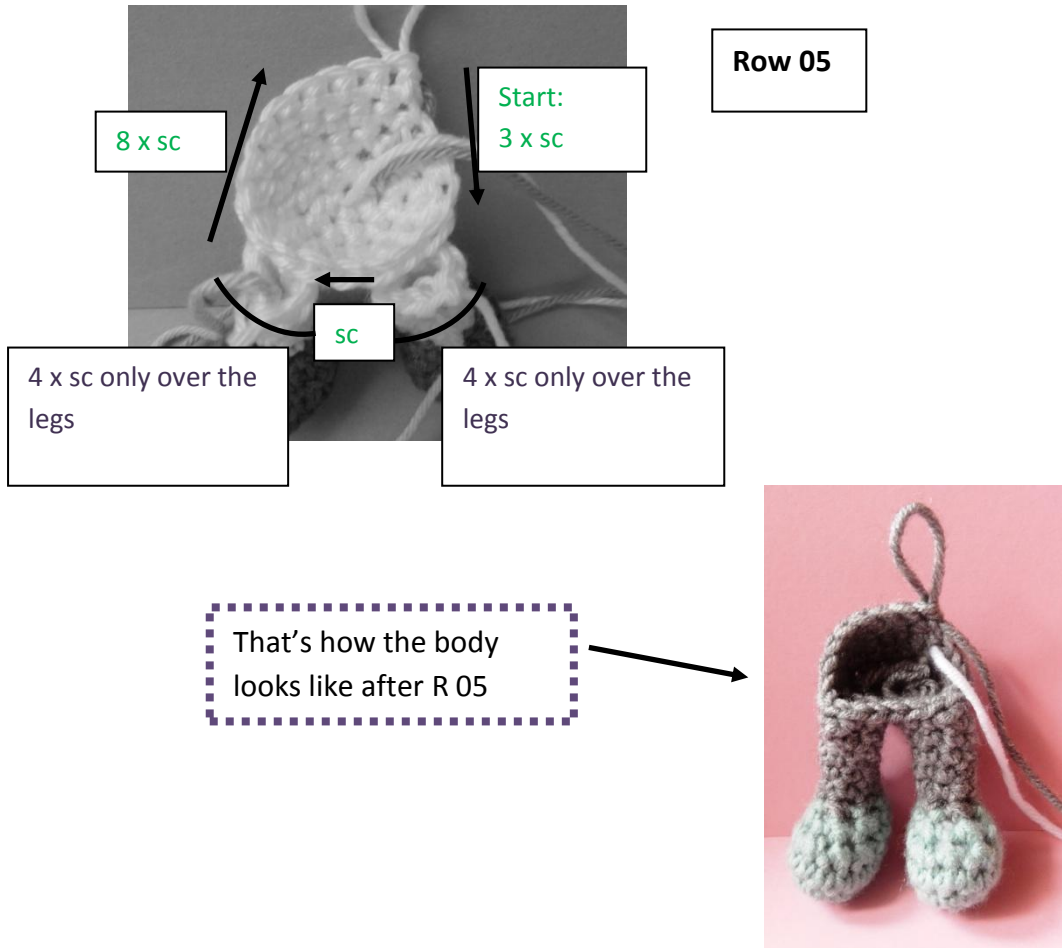

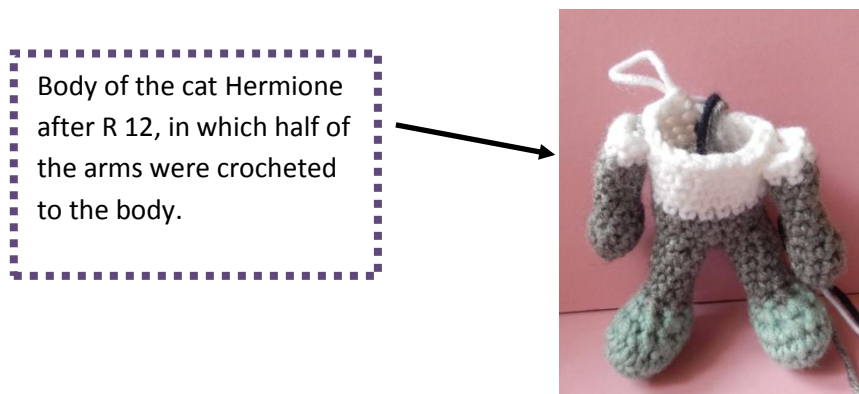
That's how the body looks like after R 04. The legs were crocheted to the body.

R 05 3 x sc,
 crochet only over the stitches of the leg: 4 x sc,
now over the body: sc,
 and then crochet over the stitches of the second leg: 4 x sc
and again over the body: 8 x sc

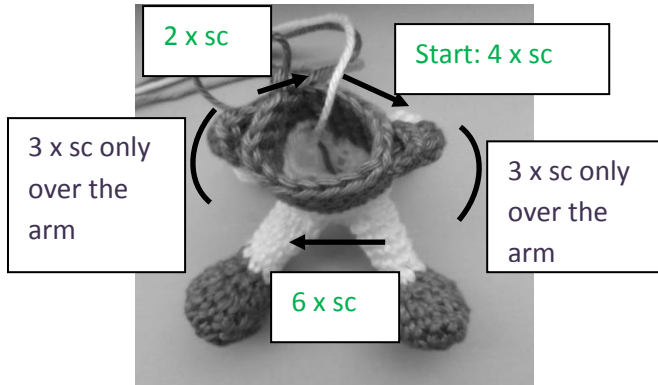


R 06 7 x sc, dec, 8 x sc, dec, sc 18
 R 07 16 x sc, **sc with color change** to white, sc 18
 R 08 – R 11 sc in each stitch 18
 R 12 4 x sc,
 now crochet the arm and the body together with 3 x sc
only on the body with 6 x sc
 then crochet the second arm and the body together with 3 x sc
only on the body with 2 x sc 18



R 13 4 x sc,
 now crochet only over the arm: 3 x sc
 6 x sc,
 crochet only over the second arm: 3 x sc
 2 x sc

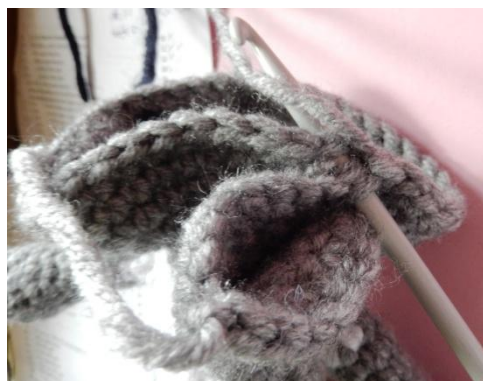

The body after R 13,
 now the arms are
 completely crocheted
 to the body



R 14	17 x sc, sc with color change to gray	18
R 15	(sc, dec) x 6, stuff the body	12
R 16	sc in each stitch	12
R 17	inc in each stitch	24
R 18	(2 x sc, inc) x 8	32
R 19	(3 x sc, inc) x 8	40
R 20	sc in each stitch	40
R 21	sc in each stitch	40
R 22	22 x sc, hold the trunk to the head and crochet head and trunk together with 9 x sc, continue crocheting only on the head: 9 x sc, see the picture	40



R 23 22 x sc, now crochet only over the trunk: 9 x sc
Then only on the head: 9 x sc

Here you can see how it looks like when the trunk is completely crocheted to the head:



R 24	23 x sc, now put in a marking thread for the eye , 8 x sc, put in a marking thread for the second eye , 9 x sc	40
R 25	sc in each stitch	40
R 26	sc in each stitch, plug in your safety eyes now , (where you have placed your marking threads for them)	40
R 27	(3 x sc, dec) x 8	32
R 28	(6 x sc, dec) x 4	28
R 29	(5 x sc, dec) x 4	24
R 30	(2 x sc, dec) x 6, stuff the head and only put a small amount of fiberfill into the trunk, so that the head gets the typical elephant shape. Do not stuff the front of the trunk.	18
R 31	(sc, dec) x 6	12
R 32	dec x 6	6

sl st, cut the thread and sew the opening

Ears (2 x)

2 ch in color gray

R 01	6 x sc in second chain from hook	6
R 02	inc in each stitch	12
R 03	(sc, inc) x 6	18
R 04	(2 x sc, inc) x 6	24
R 05	sc in each stitch	24
R 06	(dec, 10 x sc) x 2	22
R 07	sc in each stitch	22
R 08	2 x dec, 3 x sc, 4 x dec, 3 x sc, 2 x dec	14

sl st, cut the thread and sew it

Finishing

Attach the ears to the head with pins and sew them.
